Pursuant to 12 T.O.C. Chapter 1, Article VIII, Section 1807 of the Nation's Elections law, a candidate must receive the highest number of votes cast for an office in order to be declared elected. Section 1807 further provides, that if the abstract shows the vote cast for two or more candidates for an office (with the highest vote) is tied, a run-off election shall be held not more than 30 days after the election. The May 27, 2017 General Election Official Abstract for the Chukut Kuk District reflects that there is a tie in the community of Vamori between Celia M. Norris and Marcella Celaya. **Therefore, in accordance with Section 1807, a run-off election will be held in your district, in the community of Vamori for the individuals listed above on June 24, 2017.**

To vote in the Vamori Community of the Chukut Kuk District for the June 24, 2017 run-off election you must have been registered to vote in the Vamori Community for the General Election held on May 27, 2017
